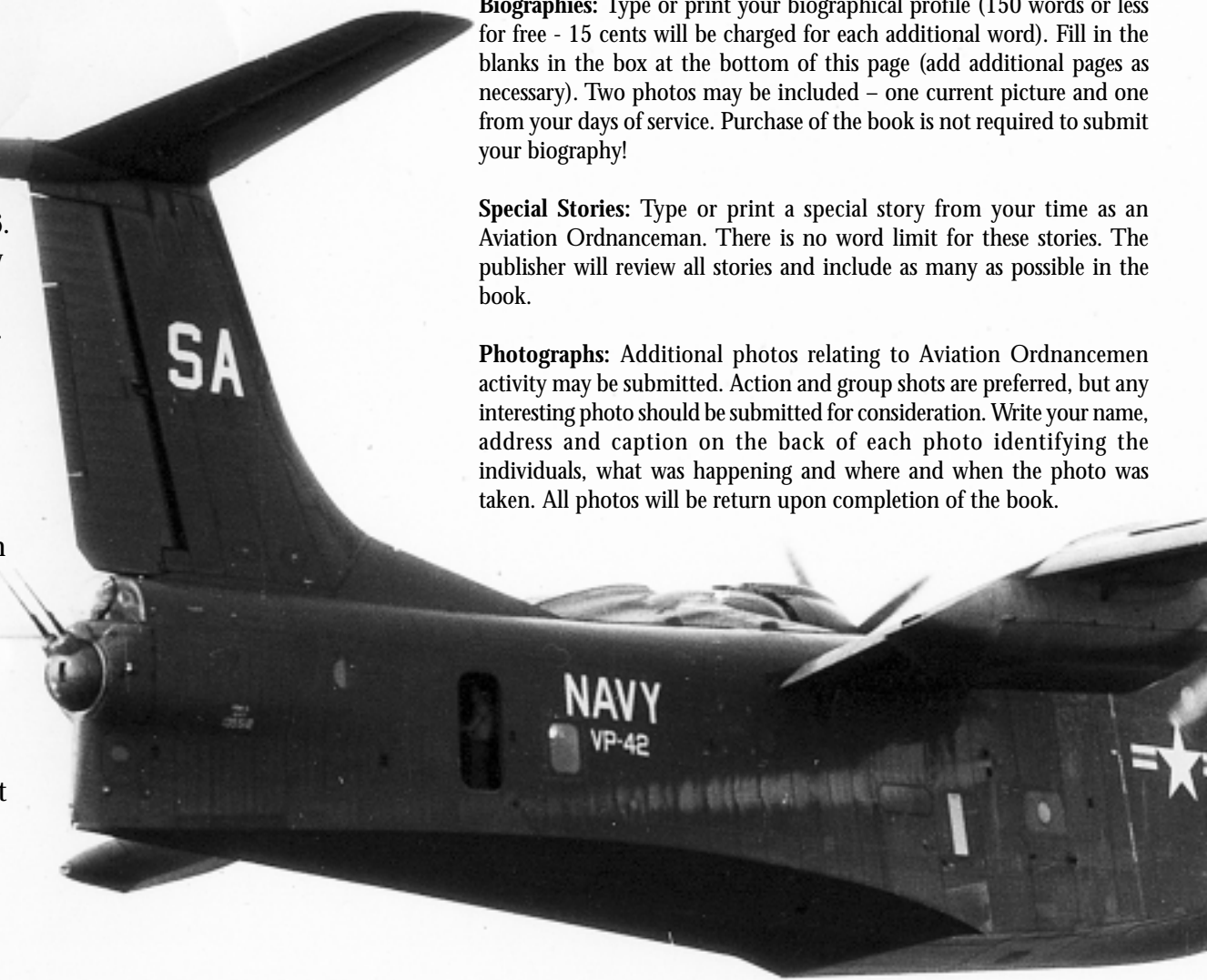

Entered the regular Army in 1954 and commissioned from Infantry OCS in 1963. He graduated from Army Aviation, Airborne and Ranger Schools. He was a Senior Army Aviator with tours in Vietnam with the 73rd AS Co. in 1966 and the 131st AS Co. in 1969. He commanded the 73rd MI Co. Hanau, FRG in 1974/75.

After his retirement from the military in 1976, he was a Warden and later a Deputy Commissioner with the Alabama Department of Corrections, retiring in 1999.

Married to Timmi, he has three grown children: Bill, Steve, and Tammy and four grandchildren.
